The Graduate Certificate in Global Leadership offers a focused curriculum in leadership with an approach that embraces diversity and inclusion. - Demonstrate effective and culturally-aware communication and negotiation skills both in direct and technology-enabled communications.
- Create clear objectives that identify competitive strategic advantages and integrate motivational strategies for employees in global teams.

Applicants must meet all entrance requirements and will be accepted on a first-qualified basis, as long as space remains.

- Hold a recognized bachelor degree in any field
- Two years of full-time post-secondary education in English in an English-speaking country with 3.0 credits of post-secondary English, humanities or social sciences (67%) from a recognized institution. Please refer to the BCIT website to learn about other ways to meet the English requirement.
